English

We will be looking at the texts 'Tell Me A Dragon, by Jackie Morris and 'The Boy Who Grew Dragons' by Andy Shepherd

We will be focusing on:

- Using noun phrases;
- Using commas in a list;
- Forming sentences using both coordinating and subordinating conjunctions;
- Using adventurous vocabulary linked to topic;
- Having an understanding of how formality affects language choices (with reference to the audience).

Please record any reading undertaken at home in your child's Home Reading Record Book, by initialling it and writing the date. You may wish to record the page number and a short comment. Please note only reading at home is recorded in this book; we keep our own records for reading in school.

Maths

The Year 2 units which will be covered include:

- Multiplication and division (2,5, and 10s);
- Fractions;
- Money;
- Position and direction.

We will be continuing to build on children's speed and fluency of number through daily arithmetic.

Science

For our science this term we will: Identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.

Geography and Art

Through our theme we will explore:

- The seven continents and 5 oceans;
- What the weather is like in these places;
- The climate and population;
- General weather patterns;
- Popular games for children from around the world.
- The work of Leonardo da Vinci;
- Sketching techniques;
- Creating tone, texture and shape with pencils.
