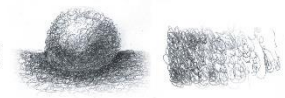

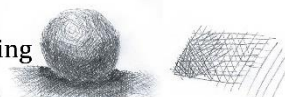

<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>English</u></b></p> <p>We will be looking at the texts 'Tell Me A Dragon, by Jackie Morris and 'The Boy Who Grew Dragons' by Andy Shepherd</p> <p>We will be focusing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Using noun phrases;</li> <li>• Using commas in a list;</li> <li>• Forming sentences using both coordinating and subordinating conjunctions;</li> <li>• Using adventurous vocabulary linked to topic;</li> <li>• Having an understanding of how formality affects language choices (with reference to the audience).</li> </ul> <p><b>Please record any reading undertaken at home in your child's Home Reading Record Book, by initialling it and writing the date. You may wish to record the page number and a short comment.</b> Please note only reading at home is recorded in this book; we keep our own records for reading in school.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>The Year 2 units which will be covered include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Multiplication and division (2,5, and 10s) ;</li> <li>• Fractions;</li> <li>• Money;</li> <li>• Position and direction.</li> </ul> <p>We will be continuing to build on children's speed and fluency of number through daily arithmetic.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>For our science this term we will:</p> <p>Identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Geography and Art</u></b></p> <p>Through our theme we will explore:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The seven continents and 5 oceans;</li> <li>• What the weather is like in these places;</li> <li>• The climate and population;</li> <li>• General weather patterns;</li> <li>• Popular games for children from around the world.</li> <li>• The work of Leonardo da Vinci;</li> <li>• Sketching techniques;</li> <li>• Creating tone, texture and shape with pencils.</li> </ul>
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
