# **Rosa Parks**



## **English**

We will be looking at 'Malala's magic pencil' by Malala Yousafzai and 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

We will be learning to:

- Select relevant content when writing for purpose;
- Use prepositions;
- Use simple sentences with subject-verb agreement,
- Use adverbials to help sequence ideas;
- Use expanded noun phrases to add detail;
- Use subordinating conjunctions to write longer sentences.

### Maths

The Year 1 units which will be covered will include:

- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s;
- Solving one step problems involving multiplication and division;
- Recognising half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity;
- Recognising and use language relating to dates, including days of the week, months and years;
- Describing position, direction and movement, including whole and half turns;
- Representing and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20.
