


# Our Local Environment

### **English**

We will be looking at a range of different stories over the half term including: Follow me Little Fox and Little Red Riding Hood.

Through these texts we will be learning to:

- Include appropriate vocabulary relating to the content;
- Write using an appropriate layout;
- Construct simple sentences that have subject-verb agreement;
- Begin to use adjectives to form expanded noun phrases;
- Order events using time word/numbers;
- Sequence sentences in short narratives.

Please record any reading undertaken at home in your child's Home Reading Record Book, by initialling it and writing the date. You may wish to record the page number and a short comment. Please note only reading at home is recorded in this book; we keep our own records for reading in school.

#### Maths

This half term we will be learning:

- Place Value We will continue to work with numbers to 100;
- Multiplication and division solving problems by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and array
- Measures money;
- Addition and subtraction.

#### **Science**

In this science unit we will be learning to:

 Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

- Construct a simple map;

#### Art

- Add colour to our work using brushes of different thickness.
