This has a different script to English and is read from left to right.</p> | <p>In French: Say and recognise numbers 1-15.</p> <p>Ask and answer the question 'Where do you live?'</p> <p>Say and recognise the vocabulary for the colours red, blue, yellow, green, white and black.</p> <p>Say and recognise the days of the week.</p> <p>Say and recognise the months of the year.</p> <p>Read and recognise some animal nouns.</p> <p>Read and recognise some fruit nouns.</p> | <p>In French: Say 4 sentences to describe themselves (name, age, home, feelings).</p> <p>Ask the question 'Where is...?' relating to a classroom object or a shop name.</p> <p>Say and recognise the vocabulary for family members.</p> <p>Use adjectives to describe an animal.</p> <p>Say and recognise vocabulary for some body parts.</p> <p>Respond to a simple sequence of physical movement commands.</p> <p>Say and understand some phrases about the weather.</p> | <p>Use a bilingual dictionary to find vocabulary.</p> <p>In French: Say an extended sentence about how they're feeling with a reason.</p> <p>Write three short sentences giving an opinion in response to a question about school subject preferences and including 'because'.</p> <p>Participate in a simple shopping dialogue to buy a gift or fruit or vegetables.</p> <p>Say and recognise some numbers between 0 and 100.</p> <p>Write a simple recipe of a salad, using the familiar fruits and vegetables and instructions.</p> <p>Say and recognise vocabulary for some clothing.</p> | <p>In French: Ask and answer some questions about own daily routine.</p> <p>Tell the time to the hour.</p> <p>Ask and answer where something is, using prepositions.</p> <p>Participate in brief conversations about themselves and others.</p> <p>Say and recognise vocabulary for sports and express like or dislike for them.</p> <p>Say and write a simple statement about favourite things.</p> <p>Participate in a café dialogue, asking for three drinks and three snacks politely.</p> |
