- All councillors reported back from their classes and brought their plans annotated with ideas for where each piece would go.
- Comments from each class included:
 - “We ordered them from easiest to hardest to the trail gets more difficult as you move round.”
 - “The teacher held each piece up and the class voted for which piece should go where.”
 - “I explained what each piece of equipment did then we voted.”
 - “We talked about which pieces might need to be near to an adult.”
 - “We didn’t put the rope pieces next to each other as they are quite similar.”
 - “We put the tyres near to Year R and KS1 as they would be able to do that quite easily.”
- The council discussed each piece and contributed ideas so that a final plan was produced.
- We took our plans outside to check the size and location of the areas chosen and that the pieces would fit where we want them. The space between the track and the fence is narrow so we had to adapt our plan and put some pieces onto the corners rather than down the long straight.
