- Feedback from Fawns was that the options chosen previously by the children would be too expensive for our school budget. We also decided that having a trail as part of the track might stop children going all the way around the Healthy Choices track and just play on the one trail.
- Mrs Hewitt shared some more examples of pieces of equipment and the children selected six of these, discussing the following points:
 - safety – would the equipment get slippery if it was damp? how high was the highest point and would children hurt themselves if they fell?
 - accessibility – would Year R and KS1 children be able to use all the equipment? would it still be enjoyable/useful for KS2?
 - health and fitness – is there a range of equipment so that different muscles are used?
- Children were then given photos of each piece of equipment along with a plan of the Healthy Choices track and Mrs Hewitt explained that they were to go back to their class and discuss where on the track each piece should go, and see what reasons their class come up with.
- Meeting closed at 3.15pm. Next meeting to be next Tuesday (3rd December) where councillors will feed back from their class discussions.
