- Mrs Hewitt shared the finalized Landscape Plan and talked through the different areas, reminding children about their ideas from the meeting with Catherine from the Hampshire Landscape Team.
- Councillors review images of 'loose parts' from catalogue and discussed advantages and disadvantages and what they might like to have in the school grounds.
- Mrs Hewitt shared a long list of materials and councilors worked together to narrow this down to 20:
  - Different length pieces of wood
  - Wooden slices (like for stepping stones)
  - Sticks
  - Water – access to a tap or pump
  - Sand and sand-pit items
  - Grassy hill
  - Chalk
  - Cardboard boxes
  - Leaves, feathers, shells, pine cones
  - Stones, pebbles, cobbles
  - Blankets
  - Tarpaulins
  - Wooden pallets
  - Buckets and baskets
  - Tubes and guttering
  - Tyres
  - Small world resources eg toy cars, figures, tea sets, food
  - Pegs
  - Ropes/string
