- The children remembered the key messages from Anti-Bullying Week Assembly:
  - Don't be a bystander
  - Reach out
  - Remember who your 5 trusted adults are
  - Bullying means repeated and intentional (on purpose) harm to someone else.
- Mrs Hewitt explained that she wanted to find out what the children at Hamble think about Bullying here and needs some questions that the Councillors could ask their classes. The School Council composed a questionnaire.
- It was suggested that we have some posters around school to remind the children about Anti-Bullying Week and how to keep safe and be kind. Mrs Hewitt printed some off the computer and the children took them around school and decided which posters should go where, thinking about key areas that children walk past every day.
