ENGLISH

Reading

- All children are expected to read daily. We provide children with a bookmark in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 to record any reading they do at home. Children in Years R, 1 and 2 have a Home Reading Diary.
- Each time they read, an adult needs, if possible, to initial and date the bookmark / diary. There are 20 spaces on the bookmark.
- In Year 5/6, children may sign the bookmark themselves if they are reading independently.

Spelling

- Spellings will not be set as homework and there will be no weekly spelling tests. Please see the 'Spelling at Hamble Primary' information sheet for more information regarding the teaching and learning of spelling through Word Study.

Year 5/6 only:

- All children will be provided with a login to the Readtheory website. This is a reading comprehension programme. Children should spend at least 20 minutes on this each week.
- From January, as we prepare the children for secondary school, Year 6 children will receive additional weekly English homework.

MATHS

Times Tables

- All children in Years 1-6 have received a login for the Times Tables Rockstars app.
- These are individually set up so that children are practising the times tables appropriate for their age.
- Children are expected to use this app to practise their times tables every week.
- Teachers will log in and check that this has been done.
- Any children unable to access this online will be given paper copies or access to a computer during learning time to ensure they are able to complete this.
- Children will also have times tables practice time in school to support the aim of achieving fluency and rapid recall.

Year 5/6 only:

- All children will receive weekly homework set on MyMaths. This will be checked by teachers and feedback will be given in class.
- Any children unable to access this online will be given paper copies or the opportunity to complete this work during school time.
- From January, as we prepare the children for secondary school, Year 6 children will receive additional weekly Maths homework.
