

## **Sports Premium Grant 2013-14**

During this year the money we received through the Sports Premium Grant was spent on:

- Autumn term – competing in the Hampshire Cup Football Tournament (£9), entering a Y5/6 boy and Y5/6 girls team, and a Y4/5 boys team. The children really enjoyed participating in these matches, despite being knocked out in the first round. This led us to set up a KS2 football club in preparation for next year (cost of new equipment £46).
- Autumn term – competed in Cross Country competitions (supply cost for PE Manager £200). After this a running club was set up with the support of the Sports Leaders from HCSC.
- Autumn term - 2 members of the teaching staff went on TOPs Training Course (2 x supply cost £400), this resulted in a greater level of confidence in PE teaching for these staff.
- Spring term – swimming gala for Y5/6 (supply cost £100)
- Spring term – after school meeting for PE Managers attended by PE Manager
- Spring term – PE manager went on a gymnastics course (course free, supply cost £100), as a result of this gymnastics training is being set up for all the teaching staff for next academic year.
- Spring term - Y4 children attended a gym festival (no costs) we won the first round, attended 2<sup>nd</sup> round (£100 supply cover cost), won this round so attended School Games (£200 supply cover cost plus £100 donation for coach to get there)
- Summer term – Y5/6 swimming teachers employed at HCSC to ensure a greater level of achievement in swimming (approximate cost £400)
- Summer term – School swimming pool new filter kit to ensure continued safe use (£500)
- Summer term – Organisation of Sports Day to ensure all children are participating in a whole school celebration of sport, linked to our school House System (£100 supply)
- Summer term – Review of last year and initial planning for use of Sports Premium Grant 2014/5, afternoon spent at information meeting about achieving the Sainsbury's Kite Mark standard. (£200 supply). Next year's Sports Day to be linked to guidance given regarding working towards the Kite Mark standard.
- Summer term – PE Conference (£125 for the conference, £200 supply) – outcome: information gathering linked to best use of Sports Premium Grant for next year, Gymnastic focus – investigation of sources of good planning for gymnastics and dance (to be in place for next academic year).
- Summer term – Action planning with Headteacher re Sports Premium Grant for 2014/5 (£100 supply)
- The rest of the grant was used in part payment of a sports coaching company, the aim of which was to raise standards and enjoyment in PE games sessions. There was a far greater level of enthusiasm seen by children who had previously been less enthusiastic about PE. This sports coaching approach is to be followed again next academic year.

## **Action Plan for Spending the Sports Premium Grant for Academic Year 2014-15**

- 'Me and My' survey to be carried out early in the autumn term to establish a baseline of attitude towards PE across the school (cost of survey £150)
- INSET day – training teaching staff in gymnastics (cost of training: £2970)
- Gymnastic and Dance planning to be put in place, provision monitored / evaluated (Mandy to timetable and cost)
- New PE equipment based on outcome of PE Health and Safety inspection
- Entry costs for Hampshire Games based competitions and related supply costs / coaches
- Funded provision of after school / lunchtime sports club – dependent upon outcomes of attitude survey.
- Anything left from the SPG will be used to part fund release time for teachers to observe the sports coach teaching games and athletics (CPD for staff).
- Cost of lifeguard training for staff to enable us to make full use of our pool. (£90 per person)
- Cost of more confident Y3/4 children using HCSC (Unable to organise due to restrictions at HCSC)
- Evaluation of swimming standards linked to skills based curriculum
