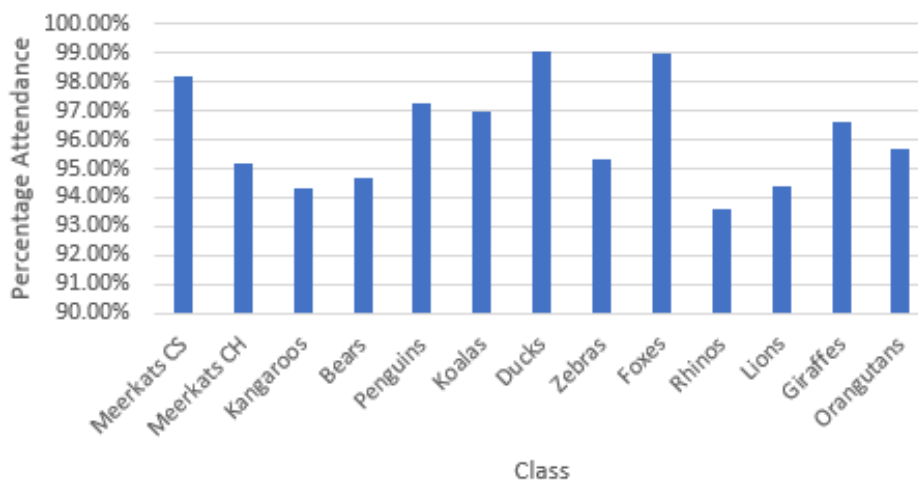
Attendance and Punctuality Matters!

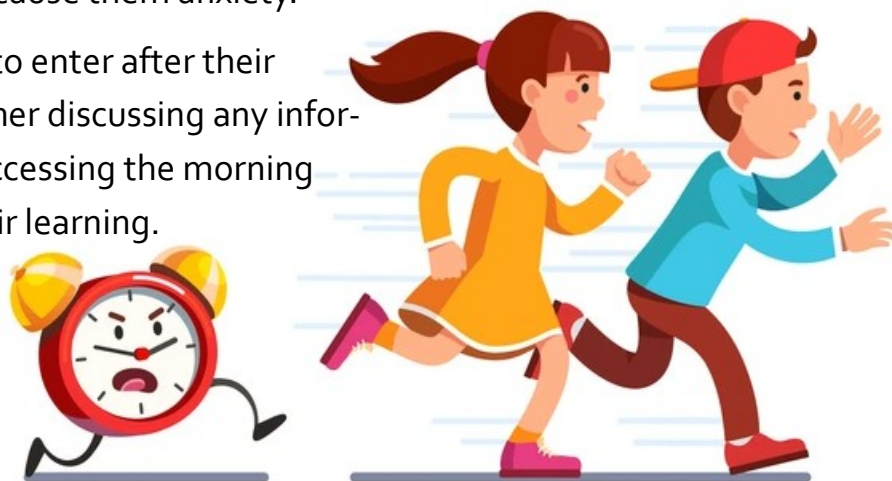
Remember to call or email the school office on 02380 453298 before 9:00am to inform us of any absence. This must be done for each day of absence.

FOCUS ON: PUNCTUALITY

Arriving to school on time is important for several reasons.

When students arrive on time to school, they are relaxed and ready to learn. When students arrive late to school, they are often rushed and stressed, which may cause them anxiety.

Arriving to class late means they have to enter after their classmates, may have missed the teacher discussing any information for that day and they are not accessing the morning tasks that teachers plan to support their learning.



DID YOU KNOW? If you are 15 minutes late each day you will have missed 2 full weeks of school in one year?

MINUTES LATE EACH DAY	NUMBER OF SCHOOL DAYS/WEEKS MISSED IN A YEAR
If you are late by the number of minutes below each and every day...	... this is how much learning time you will have missed, by the end of the year.
5 minutes	3 school days
10 minutes	6.5 days
15 minutes	10 days
20 minutes	13 days
30 minutes	19 days
